

MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE DECK SPANS BLACK LABELTM DECKING

The chart below shows the maximum allowable spans for decking products within the Black Label[™] range, based on the lowest combined mechanical properties of all species under the Black Label[™] brand.

These span limits are specific to Black Label[™] decking and grading standards and should not be used for other hardwood decking products.

The deflection for deck live loads is capped at L/360, with total deflection limited to L/240, where L represents the span length. Deflection, or bounce, is a subjective measure and can be minimized by reducing the decking span.

Building Inspectors may request signed engineering documents to confirm structural design and building code adherence. Signed and stamped engineering documents for Black Label™ decking are available upon request.
